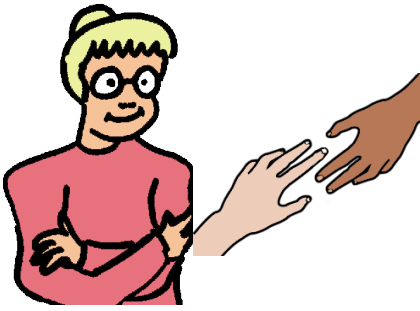




You need help to speak up.

Advocates help you to speak up.



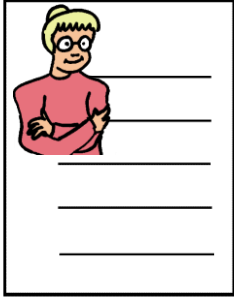
You can ask an advocate to

- get a new service.

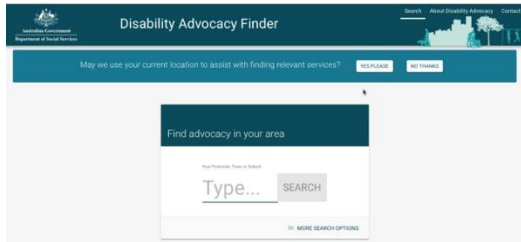


You can ask an advocate to help

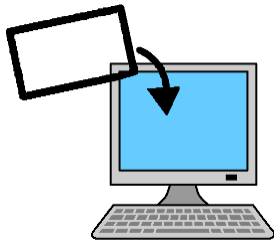
- tell services what you think
