



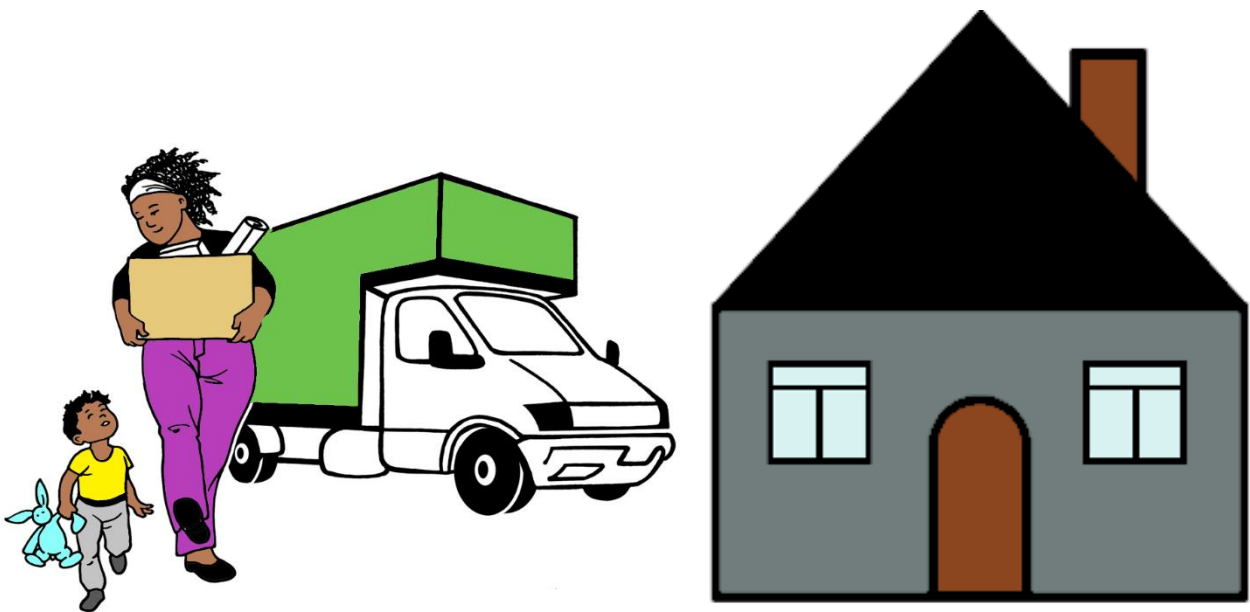

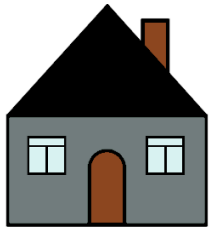

# You move in

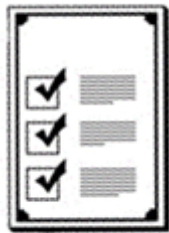


You have found your home.

It is called your **Tenancy agreement**.

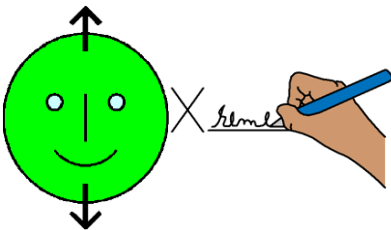


It tells you the rules. Like

You said you will follow the rules.



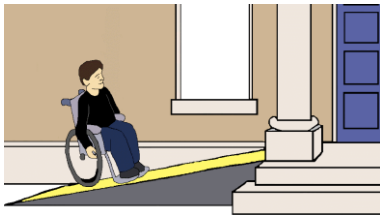
You have the keys to your home.

- Other government departments



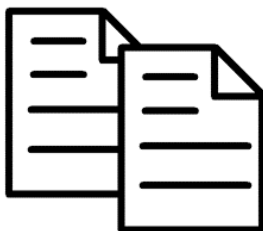
Check the house is like inhousing says it is.
