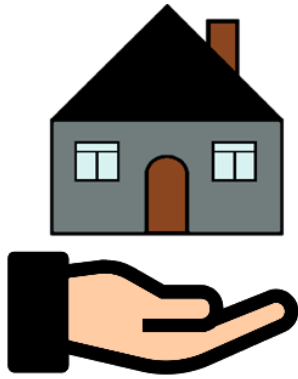




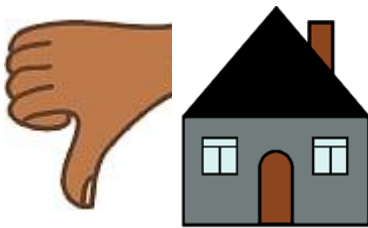
**Some thing bad happened.**

- you hit your head.

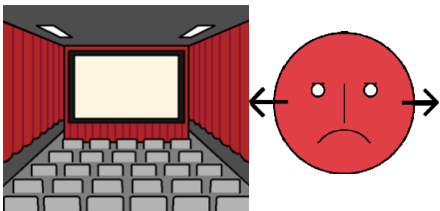
You go to hospital.

Other things may be

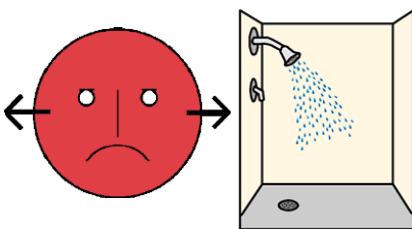
- you get really sick.

- fix the thing you fell over on

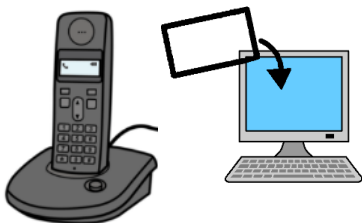


- make sure it does **not** happen again.

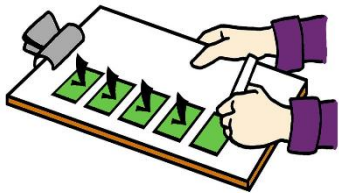

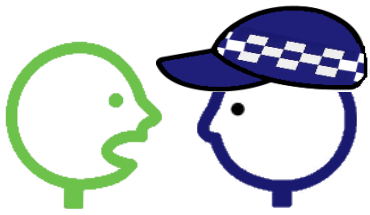
